Bali is renowned for the beauty of its sculpted rice terraces. These vibrant green plantings and layered mirrors unfold like giant stairways from the mountains to the sea. Known as *sawah*, the rice fields of Bali are centuries old, as are the democratic *subak* irrigation cooperatives that manage them. The substance of rural life is dependent on the accuracy of the water flow as it is diverted from the rivers that gush from Bali's crater lakes. Through ancient-yet-sophisticated systems of aquatic engineering, the *subak* control the flow of water to ensure the equitable and even distribution of this precious resource.

Villa Puri Bawana celebrates the *sawah*, rejoices in the richness of rural Bali and revels in an abundance of space both indoors and out. Bordered by a river, the six-bedroom villa commands views of the rice terraces, carved into the land like ancient amphitheatres, while its gardens roll down to yet another pool field where a manicured area presents a wonderfully romantic setting for a wedding. Even the curved infinity edge of the 30-metre swimming pool follows the contour of the rice terraces, and – if

the timing is right – guests will have the opportunity to plant some of this Balinese staple.

Crafted from indigenous Palimanan and Serai stone, and capped with *alang alang* thatch, the villa is a marriage of traditional Balinese style and contemporary tropical design. From its atmospheric living pavilion modelled on a Balinese *wonilon* or village meeting place, to its cream palette and understated décor, Puri Bawana is effortlessly cool. Furthermore, it is perfect for families, with frog-filled

lily ponds and high-tech surprises at every turn of its pergola-covered walkways.

Fancy some Bollinger with your Balinese black rice pudding? Why not! Like the finest Champagne, this member of the Royal Collection is unreservedly stylish, delightfully palatable and unashamedly intoxicating.
